

PRIOR CERTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT EXPERIENCE

Applicants with (2) or more years of prior certified law enforcement experience, who were employed by a state accredited agency, may qualify for additional pay. This pay is based upon the population of the municipality in which the applicant served, and the key elements of the primary work assignment. Credit may be given for up to (5) years of experience.

Lateral Entry Program

Requirements;

- United States citizen
- Minimum age of 21
- Valid driver's license
- High School diploma or GED certificate
- US Military with at least 4 years of full-time active service equates to an associate's degree
- Honorable discharge if served in the US Military
- Must successfully pass cognitive skills examination and personality assessment
- Visual ability cannot be less than 20/100 in each eye, uncorrected, and must be corrected to 20/20 with glasses, contact lens, or surgery.
- Medical examination required upon offer of employment
- Candidates must meet the minimum requirements for the position of police recruit according to the City of Roswell.
- Candidates must be employed as a full-time law enforcement officer currently or within the previous (60) months. Must have (2) years of full time sworn law enforcement experience, including at least (1) year experience as a patrol officer.
