### Big Creek Parkway – Phase 1 and 2

#### PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Big Creek Parkway project will build a new two-lane roadway across GA-400 from Warsaw Road to Old Alabama Road. It will include a new bridge over GA-400 and a new bridge over Big Creek (waterway).

The goal of the Big Creek Parkway project is to provide an alternative to the congested Holcomb Bridge interchange for travelers going between east and west Roswell. The new road will also include a sidewalk and bicycle path to make walking and biking convenient in the area. In December of 2023, the Mayor and City Council elected to revert the project alignment back to the original 2016 alignment that was approved by the voters that provided a direct connection to Warsaw Road. Also, in 2023 an IGA was formalized with GDOT to construct the bridge over GA-400 as part of GDOT's Express Lane project.
