PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Atlanta St/Oxbo Road Intersection realigned Oxbo Road and Oxbo Drive to eliminate the staggered intersection at SR 9/SR 120/Atlanta Street and converted Oxbo Drive to a two-way street between Mimosa Boulevard and Atlanta Street (SR 9/120).

Turning lanes on both Hwy 9/Atlanta Street and Oxbo Road were added, as well as the addition of a new traffic signal at the intersection. Elm Street was also extended from its existing terminus at Maple Street to the intersection of Oxbo Road and Pleasant Hill Street. The project also extended Oxbo Road west to connect to Mimosa Blvd for better access to SR 120/Marietta Hwy and the Magnolia Street / Pine Grove Road corridors.

The project was determined to be substantially complete and was open to traffic on June 30, 2023. The project's final inspection and any remaining construction are to be completed before Autumn of 2023.
