JOB SUMMARY

This position will teach gymnastics and cheer classes at the East Roswell Recreation Center for toddler, preschool and early elementary age. These classes are designed to teach children socialization skills outside the home (taking turns, following directions in a class setting) along with introducing them to different body movements. Classes are divided by age (beginning at 16 months – 8 years) and are 45 min or 2 hours each.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Teach children basic instruction, motor skills, and beginning skills of gymnastics and cheer.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Education and Experience:

- Experience in Gymnastics, Cheer, Physical Education or Child Development.
- Experience working with children.

Licenses or Certifications:

- First Aid/CPR preferred

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Must be responsible, creative, energetic and able to instruct a class of 6-9 children on their own.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Tasks require the ability to exert moderate, though not constant physical effort, typically involving some combination of climbing and balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, and crawling, and which may involve some lifting, carrying, pushing and/or pulling of objects and materials of light to moderate weight (10-50 pounds). Some tasks require the ability to communicate orally.
