- Replace sign and create a landscaped park entrance on Fouts Road easily recognizable and clearly visible from road
- Make facilities available to everyone by creating ADA compliant parking for the Arts Center East and create more efficient general parking by decreasing overall pavement area
- Create an outdoor gathering area in front of the Art Center for classes, events, and activities




Complete Trail for East Roswell Park

- Decrease the number of driveway access locations to minimize vehicle and pedestrian crossings
- Complete the walking loop around park

In order to make the Art Center East accessible to all community members, we will be removing and replacing trees in specific areas to accommodate these improvements.

Approximately 60 Trees total
31 Pines 6"-12" Diameter (dbh)
20 Pines 12"-16" Diameter (dbh)
9 Sweetgum 6"-10" Diameter (dbh)

Trees Replaced

Approximately 20-30 Trees
Hardwood Tree mix: Maple, Oak, River Birch and Bald Cypress.
Flowering tree mix to include: Serviceberry, Flowering Dogwood and Redbud
Evergreen tree mix to include: Southern & Sweetbay Magnolia, Holly, Ornamental Red Cedar

East Roswell Park Improvement Project

Dear Roswell Resident,

We are excited to announce plans to update, improve, and beautify the look to the East Roswell Park Entrance off Fouts Road, which will provide a better experience for visitors, neighbors, and volunteers. The project is located at 9100 Fouts Road at the entrance to our Art Center East Facility.

These renovations will include:

- Improving aesthetics by replacing the landmark sign and landscaping the front entrance, making it clearly visible and easily recognizable from the road
- Increasing trail connectivity and minimizing vehicle and pedestrian crossings by completing the loop trail around the perimeter of the park
- Creating an outdoor gathering area in front of the Art Center for classes, events, and activities
- Making park and facilities available to everyone by creating ADA parking for Arts Center East

In order to complete these renovations, we will be removing a number of trees to allow for an easily accessible parking lot at Art Center East. We will be replacing the majority of these trees with a variety of hard wood, flowering, and evergreen species and placing them in an area of the park that allows for the planned renovations as well as beautifies the community.

Our Recreation and Parks Department would like to invite you to a public walk-thru of the area where these renovations will be taking place and answer any questions you may have about the process. All residents are invited to join us at East Roswell Park on Saturday, Jan 26 at 10AM to see the exciting improvements we will be initiating in February!
