

# Chattahoochee Pedestrian Bridge

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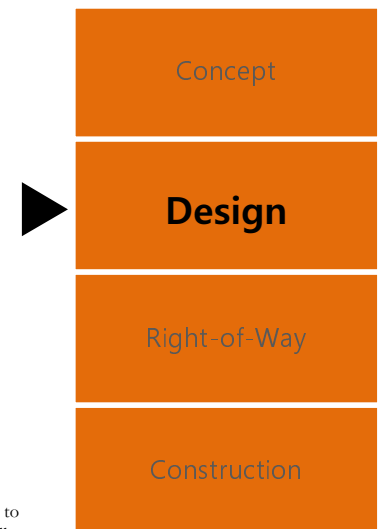


## PROJECT OVERVIEW

The pedestrian improvements to SR 9 at the Chattahoochee River are a key element of Roswell and Sandy Springs' efforts to revitalize the SR 9 corridor and to promote and enhance recreational and multimodal use of bicycle and pedestrian facilities. The goals of this project are to improve safety and operations, and increase multimodal connectivity.

This project was originally funded with a Federal earmark (\$3 million) and local funds from both cities. Because Federal money is involved, this project must continue to follow the Federal environmental guidelines as well as coordinate with GDOT and FHWA. Although Roswell is the official sponsor of the project, Sandy Springs has agreed to share the local match 50/50 with Roswell.
